OPTION A: 10 MONTHS - REGULAR ACADEMIC YEAR, AUGUST 29, 2022 TO JUNE 2023

Tuition Fees include the following from August 29, 2022 to June 2023, except for three weeks of holidays at Christmas break, two weeks of March break, and statutory and school holidays: tuition fees, before and/or after school supervision, last week of June AcadeCamp, snacks and hot lunch meals, learning materials and basic supplies, outings and transportation related to the units of inquiry and administration fees.

Full-Time before March 1

Per child: \$18,500.00 (10 x \$1,850.00)

OPTION B: 10 MONTHS - EXTENDED ACADEMIC YEAR, AUGUST 29, 2022 TO JUNE 2023, PLUS SUMMER SESSIONS OF ACADECAMP

Tuition Fees include the following, from August 29, 2022 to June plus summer sessions of AcadeCamp except for three weeks of holidays in Christmas break, two weeks of March break, and statutory and school holidays: tuition fees, before and/or after school supervision, Summer AcadeCamp sessions, snacks and hot lunch meals, learning materials and supplies, outings and transportation related to the units of inquiry and administration fees. Hot lunch meals included.

SIBLING DISCOUNT - 10% tuition fee discount for attendance by sibling

A \$50.00 surcharge shall be levied for any cheque dishonoured, payable within 30 days from the School recovering notice of such dishonour. **A 2% interest applies to late payments.**

In exceptional circumstances only, a deferred payment schedule can be negotiated with the Finance Office of École internationale Acadecap International School. A \$575.00 administration fee will apply.

***Additional fees may apply for water polo, ski lessons and lift, other out-of-school sports activities, trips and transportation not related to the unit of inquiry such as nature walks and end-of-year trips, and meals. The cost of the uniform is also the client's responsibility.*

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FEE \$1,700.00*

Each new international application also carries a non-refundable supplementary administration fee when enrolled through AcadeCap Finance. This fee is not an advance payment of tuition and cannot be applied to other outstanding amounts.

*An additional charge of **\$4,040.00** applies to enrollments through an external agency.

YEARLY STUDENT CHARGE ACCOUNT FEE \$975.00

Yearly student charge account fee covers incidental charges for intra/extra-curricular activities such as outside sports, transportation for non-unit related trips, enrichment activities, end of year activities, etc. and is due on August 29, 2022.

Other Services, Fees

A) NEW STUDENT FEES

APPLICATION FEE

\$185.00 Each new application carries a one-time, non-refundable fee that covers the cost of processing the student's application, including student assessment and a visit day. The student's application will only be reviewed upon receipt of payment.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP FEE

\$550.00 One-time, non-refundable fee charged once the family accepts an invitation to join the School. This fee is not an advance payment of tuition and cannot be applied to other outstanding amounts. Parents will be required to sign the School Enrollment Contract at this time. A child's place is only assured once this is settled and all documents required have been submitted.

B) SUPERVISION SERVICE

The Optional Supervision Service is offered Monday to Friday, from 7:30 am to 9:00 am and from 4:00 pm to 5:30 p.m. Parents may choose from:

If no Supervision Service option is chosen, drop-offs before 8:30 am and pick-ups after 4:30 pm are subject to a \$15.00 fee.

*A \$25.00 fee will be charged for every late pick-up, after 5:30 P.M., and is payable upon the next day when dropping off your child. **Supervision fees are non-refundable.***

C) ESL/FSL PROGRAMME

Additional ESL or FSL support is provided to foreign language students (4 x 45 minutes /weekly). The ESL or FSL programme is available at the additional non-refundable cost of \$3,900.00 for the school year, payable on August 29, 2022 or in 3 equal payments.

D) SYSTEMATIC MULTISENSORY INTENSIVE LITERACY EDUCATION (SMILE) PROGRAMME FOR READING/WRITING

Using the **Systematic Multisensory Intensive Literacy Education (SMILE)** programme teachers work, individually or in a small group, with children who require additional reading and/or writing instruction (4 x 45 minutes/weekly). The SMILE programme uses a **systematic multisensory** reading and writing method based on the **Orton-Gillingham Approach**; and our teachers are trained in the Orton-Gillingham Approach in accordance with the goals and guidelines outlined by the Academy of Orton-Gillingham Practitioners and Educators (AOGPE). Acadecap International School is a member of the International Dyslexia Association.

A student in the SMILE programme is accommodated, with **multisensory learning and with assistive technology** supports, in all areas of the curriculum, based on teacher monitoring, documentation, analysis and measuring of student success in tasks that link with each subject and/or grade level expectations and on demonstrated learning behaviours.

A student in the SMILE programme, and concurrently learning in the IB PYP, benefits from a curriculum with a **multisensory** approach enabling learners to develop and deepen conceptual understandings, to acquire subject knowledge and to develop the learning and life skills relevant to this day and age. Acadecap International School's small groups of students in ratio to homeroom teachers and specialists make this multisensory differentiated approach possible.

E) CLASSROOM INDIVIDUALIZED SUPPORT (CIS)

The School provides individualized support to students with exceptionalities when the need for one-to-one support has been identified. Through the CIS, the homeroom teacher may work alongside a specialist from the School providing individualized support within a group situation. Or in some cases, a teacher may be assigned to support the Student one-to-one for most of the day.

The CIS fee covers assessments, additional planning and scheduling time, meetings and learning materials. In addition to the CIS fee, an hourly rate of \$40 will apply for the services of an Acadecap specialist if one-on-one support is required; i.e trained in ABA, Braille, Sign Language, etc.



The CIS programme is available at the additional non-refundable cost of \$8,700.00 for the school year, payable on the first day of school or in 3 equal payments of \$2,900.00.

For educational as well as administrative purposes, a student enrolled in the CIS is expected to complete the year’s programme.

F) FULL TIME LIVE ONLINE OPTION/TELELEARNING

For full time learning via Live Online Option and/or Telelearning while instruction is in person, there is an additional fee of \$1,440.00 per school year. Spaces are capped. No refund once the trimester has started.

WHAT DO THE TUITION FEES PAY FOR? *SUBJECT TO CHANGE FROM TIME TO TIME

- Teacher training and workshops (\$900.00 USD per teacher per IB workshop)

- Staff Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and Screens for the school
