Grade 7/8 Humanities Board Games

The global pandemic has brought forth many changes in our lives. With the increase of family time spent indoors, board games became an engaging way to pass time. Students in Grade 7 and 8 will use their knowledge about Canada and its global relationships during the 18th and 19th century, to develop their own game. The board game will emphasize a particularly important event during this period of history and will include pawns/characters of significant historical relevance. For inspiration, students enjoyed a morning playing strategic and logic board games.



Biology 11 Fetal Pig Dissection

A fetal pig dissection provides a hands-on opportunity for students to engage in an investigation of anatomy and physiology. The fetal pig is chosen because it has body systems that are similar to the human body systems. During the dissection, students make links between structure and function and begin to identify interrelationships between the circulatory, respiratory, and digestive systems.
